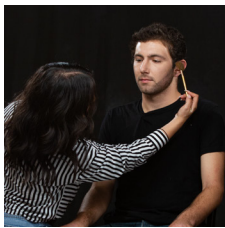

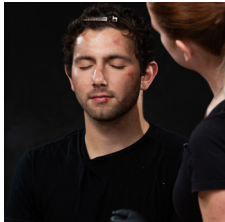

STEP 1

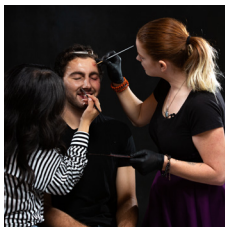
Makeup

- Prep and prime the skin with mineral water to tone, applying a face moisturizer and a lip conditioner.
- Apply cream or liquid foundation to even skin tone, be sure to use a light application.
- Use a small added amount of foundation to cover any blemishes or redness.
- Set foundation with a translucent powder.
- Apply bronzer under cheek bones and temple/forehead area.
- To achieve Teddy's classically handsome look, you want to make sure you look natural.



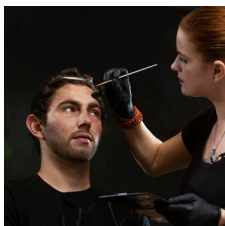
Grooming

- If you already have facial hair, trim down to a rough five o'clock shadow.
- If you do not, use a paint brush to flick dark brown pigment against the skin to create a five o'clock shadow effect.
- You can find a synthetic bristle paint brush at your local hardware store.
- Can't make it to the store? Use an old (clean!) toothbrush to achieve a similar effect.



Sun and Dirt

- Using an alcohol activated makeup palette or face paint, use a paint brush cut down and flick peach and pink tones on the skin.
- Using makeup dirt, and a fluffy brush or fan brush, tap dirt and dust on in random spots.
- If you do not have makeup dirt, you can also use matte blush to redden your skin and matte brown eyeshadow with a fluffy makeup brush, and dust it on in random spots.
- You can find inexpensive blush and eyeshadows at a local drugstore or dollar store.



STEP 2

Cuts and Scrapes

- Using the same alcohol makeup palette and small brush, add redness and localized cuts in areas to the face at random.
- If you do not have alcohol makeup palette or face paint, use a mascara wand and red lipstick and swipe across the face in random spots to create scrapes and cuts.
- You can find mascara wands or paint brushes, and inexpensive lipsticks, at a local drugstore or dollar store.
- You can find fake blood at any Halloween store.
