## Course Descriptions

### ACRI (Adolescent Critical Reading Intervention)

is an targeted adolescent literacy intervention focused on academic literacy and critical thinking with text designed to bring Upper Elementary, Middle, and High School students to grade level quickly. ACRI is based on fifty years of state-of-the-art literacy research. Elements of ACRI include:

- Inferential Questioning
- Questioning the Author

### EBLI (Evidence Based Literacy Instruction)

is a research-based, systematic and comprehensive literacy system with a strong focus on phonemic awareness and phonics. Instruction is streamlined, explicit, concise, multi-sensory and pattern-based. This one-day workshop provides an overview of EBLI as well as instruction in basic EBLI strategies to improve reading performance. Presenter: Nora Chahbazi, creator of EBLI.

**Handwriting Without Tears** is a developmentally-based program which pays attention to the developmental needs of people who are trying to learn how to write. Select K-2 Printing, 3-5 Cursive, or both. Presenter: Paula Heinircher, consultant.

**Workshop Way** is a holistic management system of human growth for education which promotes literacy skills through classroom management routines, humane teacher-student-content interactions which preserve the dignity of all students, and a variety of instructional techniques to help students discover they can learn, can think, can read, and can manage their young lives with more courage and confidence. **Teach Writing Well – The 6+1 Writing Traits & Beyond** is a research-proven system to improve writing for all grade levels. Teachers who are already familiar with the traits will benefit from the additional strategies using mentor texts, and exciting new ways of incorporating traits and their key qualities into assessing and teaching writing.
