Course Descriptions

Words Their Way is a developmental spelling, phonics, and vocabulary program. It was developed by Invernizzi, Johnston, Bear, and Templeton and is intended to be a part of comprehensive literacy instruction. Presenters: Dr. Lori Helman and Pearson Literacy Specialist Samantha Richardson.

ACRI (Adolescent Critical Reading Intervention)

is an targeted adolescent literacy intervention focused on academic literacy and critical thinking with text designed to bring Upper Elementary, Middle, and High School students to grade level quickly. ACRI is based on fifty years of state-of-the-art literacy research. Elements of ACRI include:
