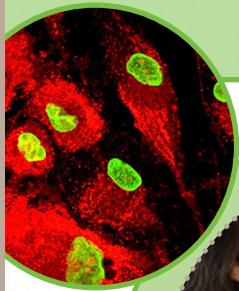


HOW YOUR BABY'S CORD BLOOD IS STORED

Umbilical cord blood is a rich source of stem cells, which are used in transplants for treatment of conditions including blood cancers and immune disorders.



Your baby's cord blood is collected at the hospital.

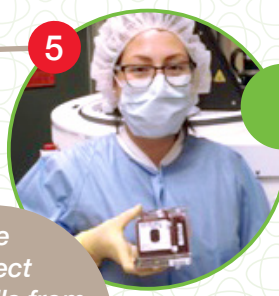
Your donation arrives at the Texas Cord Blood Bank.
