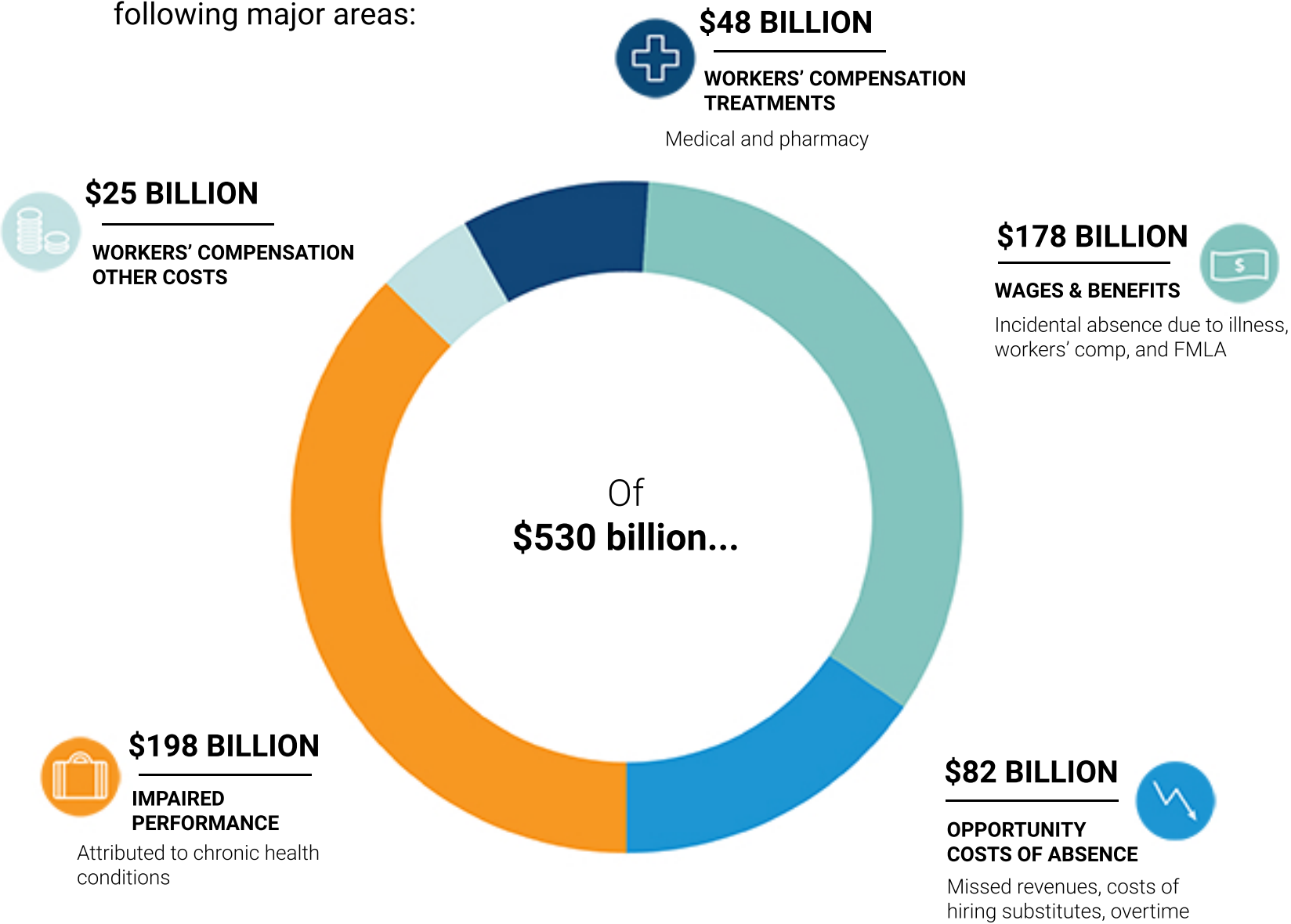


# POOR HEALTH COSTS US EMPLOYERS

Annually, poor health costs US employers\*\*:

**\$530 BILLION**

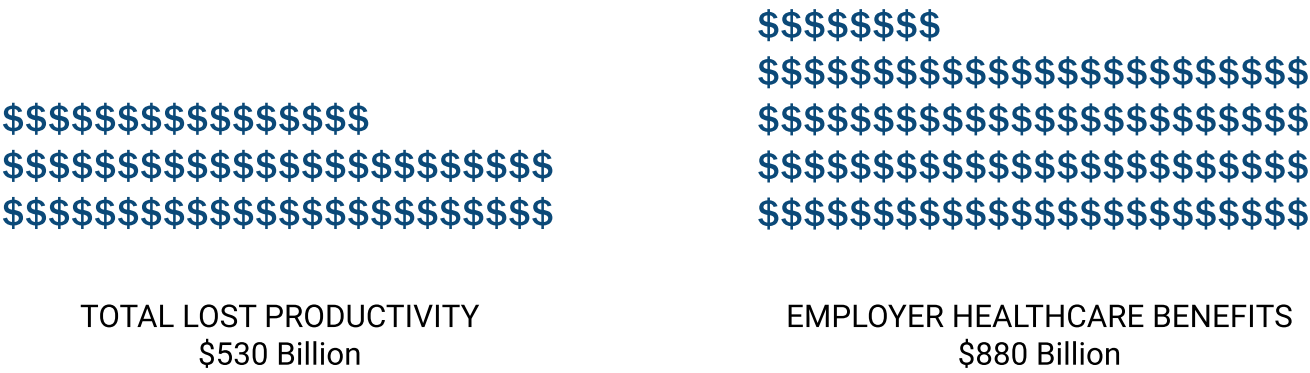
The estimated costs are categorized into the following major areas:



\*Employer healthcare benefits estimated at \$0.12 for every dollar of payroll wages (incl. employees and dependents).

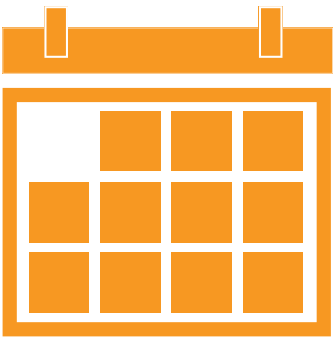

For every dollar spent on healthcare benefits, \$0.60 is lost to illness and injury:
