

AEROMEXICO ANNOUNCES THE LAUNCH OF ITS NEW PORTLAND-MEXICO CITY ROUTE

Portland, December 7, 2017.- Aeromexico, Mexico's global airline, along with its partner Delta Air Lines, announced the launch of a new route between Portland, Oregon, and Mexico City beginning on December 1, 2017.

Portland is one of the fastest growing tech and innovation hubs in the United States, and it is recognized as a major center for entrepreneurship and business development that could attract new investment opportunities with this route.

Service on the route is provided with Boeing 737-800 aircraft featuring 160 passenger seats –16 in Clase Premier, Aeromexico's Business Class cabin, with the following flight schedules:

"For Aeromexico, the launch of this new route reflects the efforts that both airlines have made to increase transborder connectivity", said Jorge Goytortua, Aeromexico's SVP Global Sales. "Portland will now have access to Aeromexico's main hub in Mexico City where customers can connect directly to 15 destinations in Latin America in addition to destinations across Mexico on the routes we currently serve".

Port of Portland Executive Director Curtis Robinhold added: "This new nonstop flight to Mexico City is good for the people in our region as it helps further improve and encourage business and tourism. The strength of Aeromexico's network and their partnership with Delta Air Lines is a welcome offering for our travelers".
